Recognizing National Donate Life Month

In April, Phoenix Children's joined children's hospitals around the nation to recognize the importance of being a donor and celebrating the lives saved through donation.

In 2017, Phoenix Children's performed 20 [kidney transplants](#), making us the eighth largest provider for this operation

nationally.

Our [liver transplant program](#), which began in 2012, performed seven liver transplants in 2017.

[Phoenix Children's Heart Center](#) has performed 80 transplants from 2011 to 2017, with 14 of these transplants completed in last year. This is the sixth largest volume nationally. We were one of 54 heart transplant programs that performed at least one pediatric heart transplant in 2017.
