

Research Volunteers Needed

The Bubba Watson and PING Golf Motion Analysis Laboratory is conducting stair climbing research here at Phoenix Children's Hospital. This project will involve **typically developing children** and **patients with cerebral palsy**. The purpose of the study is to measure the different ways children go up and down stairs. The children that may participate must:

- Be between the ages of 7 and 17 years of age
- Be able to stand for at least one minute
- Be able to climb and descend a flight of five stairs
- Be able to follow verbal instructions

The study will be conducted between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, on the 2nd floor of the Main Building, Phoenix Children's Hospital.

The testing sessions may last up to 2 hours and 15 minutes. There will be no painful procedures or shots. A parent must sign a consent form for each child participating. Enrollment is based upon a brief examination by a licensed physical therapist. A \$40 gift card will be given to those children that qualify and complete the experimental testing.
