

CRS Cardiology Care

Dear CRS cardiology families,

We have heard some questions regarding whether children enrolled in the CRS program will be able to continue to receive cardiology care at Phoenix Children's after October 1, 2018 if their child's AHCCCS Complete Care (ACC) Plan is not in network with Phoenix Children's. Phoenix

Children's is an in-network provider with five of the seven ACC plans, including Care 1st, Steward Health Choice Arizona, Banner University Family Care, Mercy Care, and UnitedHealthcare Community Plan. We continue to work with the other ACC plans to have our care and facilities in-network with those plans as well.

If Phoenix Children's is not in network with a child's ACC plan and the child clinically needs to come to Phoenix Children's to receive cardiology care after October 1, 2018, we can contact the ACC plan to request a pre-authorization for any needed services. As part of the pre-authorization process, Phoenix Children's providers will provide information to the ACC plan substantiating the clinical necessity of the child receiving care from a Phoenix Children's provider. If the pre-authorization request is approved by the plan, care at Phoenix Children's will be covered by the ACC plan.
